Fall

Prereq.: good academic standing, no German required. Reg. Load: 4 credits

GER 14/67/119: "German Language and Culture" (double credit; GER 198 and 199/298 and 299/381 and 382)

Choose two of the three:

ART 190: "Berlin Architecture" (ART 199)

ECO 160: "Economics of the EU" (ECO 199)

POL 100: "Environmental Policy" (POL 199 or HIS 199)

(possibility of 4th course at Humboldt or TU in the true WS: Oct-Feb)

Spring

Prereq.: 16 course credits, 2 years of German. Reg. Load: 4 credits

GER 151: "Advanced Intensive German" (GER 383)

GER 152: "Berlin in Literature and Culture" (GER 385)

Choose either POL plus 1 or 2 FU/TU courses; or no POL but up to three FU/TU courses.

POL 100: "Germany a Superpower?" (POL 199)

Spring Engineering/Sciences

Prereq.: 16 course credits, 2 years of German. Reg. Load: 4 credits

GER 68: "Intensive Intermediate German" (GER 299)
in January; ("January Course")

GER 151: "Advanced Intensive German" (GER 383)
to mid-April
