Potential employers can post job openings, come to campus to interview Davidson students, and host information sessions, or interview candidates in Chicago, Boston, New York or Washington DC.

Post Position Openings on eCareers

Employers who are interested in recruiting Davidson students or graduates for full-time or part-time positions, internships, or summer jobs are encouraged to establish a position posting to collect applications through Davidson College's eCareers database. This service is **free**. We also post entry-level to 5 years experience openings for the young Davidson alumni who have an active account in our system. Attend Davidson College Career Fairs

Davidson College hosts 2 career fairs annually. The next one targeting full-time positions, internships and graduate programs will be held on **Wednesday, September 23, 2009**. A January Summer Jobs and Camps Fair is scheduled for **Wednesday, January 27, 2010**.

Host an Information Session

Hosting an information session is an effective way to generate interest in your company or organization. The Career Services staff can publicize your event through targeted e-mails to students interested in a particular employer, field, or job function. To ensure a successful information session, presenters should focus on:

- Distinctions that set your organization apart from others in your industry.
- Recent contracts, product releases, and news events, whether they are positive or negative.
- Examples highlighting career paths, and opportunities for new professionals.
- Example of a typical day and what you expect from a new hire.
- What you look for in competencies, skills, special backgrounds or talents.
- Lifestyle, corporate culture, mission and vision, corporate values.
- Work locations and travel requirements.
- Why people choose to join your organization.

Interview Davidson Students On-Campus October - November and January - March

Davidson students interview on campus *to obtain internships and full-time career positions*. Employers schedule a date to visit Davidson and interview candidates using pre-screened or open sign-ups through eCareers.

Staff an Information Table

Information tables can be reserved from September through April. The table is in a high traffic area of the Alvarez Student Union between the Post Office and the Bookstore and on the path to the Union Cafe. This is useful if organizations want to build recognition with students and cannot come to campus for our career fairs.

- Schedule your table from *11:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.*, the busiest time of the day.
- Schedule at least *two weeks in advance* so we can advertise for you.
- Set an attractive, eye catching display stand -- don't sit at your table, and wear a smile .
- Utilize your Davidson student contacts to help you advertise your visit.

Off-Campus Opportunities

Participate in interview days in Chicago, Boston, New York City and Washington DC.

Davidson College participates in the Selective Liberal Arts Consortium (SLAC), a group of 14 liberal arts colleges sponsoring interview days for graduating college seniors. Employers win because they don't have to travel to 14 schools to recruit, and students win by having access to multiple employers in a single interview day.

SLAC Interview Days 2009-2010:

Chicago on *Friday, December 4, 2009*;
 Boston on *Wednesday, January 6, 2010*;
 New York City on *Thursday, January 7, 2010*;
 Washington, DC on *Monday, January 11, 2010*.
